Thank you for being a part of the mission to help us serve such a faith-based, quality education that impacts these Rochester youth for the rest of their lives!



School at Home

In March when schools across the state had to pivot to distance learning, Nativity immediately began synchronous instruction for all students, allowing for the continuation of all core subjects, plus religion, gym, and homeroom. Class content was pared down to ensure learning acquisition of key skills in a new format while minimizing volume to maintain student participation. Additional opportunities for connection and maintaining community were provided weekly, including game nights, movie watching parties, and virtual field trips. Throughout the spring, with regular follow up to students from teachers, attendance hovered at 95%. Donor support allowed us to provide students with continued learning and enrichment opportunities that helped to build bridges to their success now and in the future. 


