<p>Assumptions</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Nativity alumni require assistance navigating the high school and post-high school process more so than their non-Nativity peers at private schools due to historical structural disenfranchisement and thus less familial understanding of private high schools and the post-high school process • With supplemental resources, Nativity alumni can succeed at the same rate as their non-Nativity peers at their college-prep high schools 	<p>External Factors</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Positive and negative influences from high schools, families, and communities can draw students in opposing directions • Student socioeconomic status and demographics add additional layers of complexity as they relate to high school and post high school academic access and opportunity
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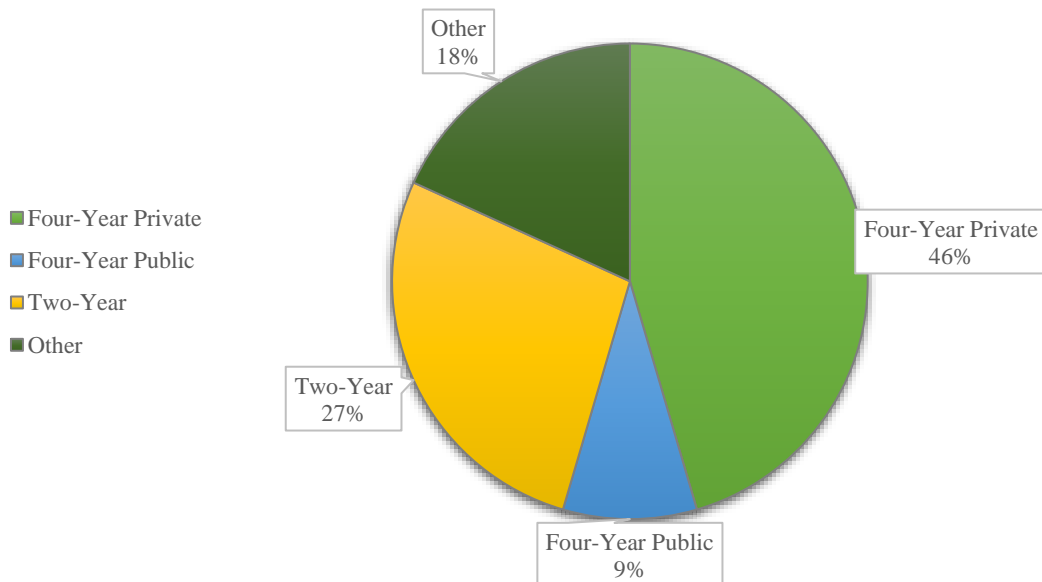
