Two of our Nativity graduates shared their thoughts about their time at our school with their classmates and the many quests who joined us for the celebration:

"The advice I would like to give to a potential Nativity student is to never lack confidence, always know your worth, and to always know that you're doing this for you and your future.

Nativity saved my life. Without Nativity I would lack the confidence to stand up to people when they're talking down to me, and telling me that I wouldn't be anything in life. I would have never thought of having goals, a future, and a career. Nativity put me on a just and righteous path. Before Nativity, I always thought I would end up like some other kids I have heard about with no education, no moral support from family or friends, or without a strong head on their shoulders. Before I came to Nativity I actually never knew the true meaning of spiritual growth. But now I can say what it means; going beyond the mind and ego and realizing who you really are. The stories I have behind spiritual growth are mind blowing because never in a million years would I have seen myself as a role model for younger students. A few years ago, I was not mature enough to be thought of as a role model. Nativity has guided me well through emerging adolescence and early adulthood. I have seen myself mature so much over the last four years. I went from being shy to properly addressing people as "yes ma'am" "no ma'am," and shaking someone's hand when they walk through the door. I also value the virtues more and more

Thanks to my Nativity education, and the overall experience, I feel confident and prepared for the next step in my academic career. I will not only use what I learned at Nativity in high school, but I will also use it throughout my journey in this big world. I would like to finish high school, go to the University of Rochester, get my MBA for business, and start my own business. I have seen a lot of failure in my life, but I will not fail! 





AT NATIVITY PREP





One of the unique aspects of Nativity Prep is the Extended Day Program. School begins each day at 7:30am and wraps up at 5:30pm Monday through Thursday, and 3:00pm on Fridays.

The day begins with homeroom and breakfast, after which the school community gathers to pray and recite the Nativity Pledge at morning assembly.

After a full day of classes, and a hot lunch, students have an hour dedicated to homework, with a parade of volunteer tutors coming to school to assist in any way they can.

The final hour of the day is used for our Enrichment Program, where students have the opportunity to participate in dozens of extra-curricular activities, including tennis, basketball, music lessons, step dancing, cooking, bowling, computer programming, field trips the choices are endless!

At the end of the day, our students head home with an abundance of knowledge, endless stories to share about new experiences, and memories that will last a lifetime!







Summer at Mativity

One of the important aspects of a Nativity education

At Nativity Preparatory Academy, summer is not a vacation but rather a time for continued academic development

as well as cultural enrichment and bonding for our students in a safe and supportive environment. At Nativity's Summer Gear-Up Academic and Leadership Program, we focus on:

- Providing academic continuity over the summer to prevent summer learning loss.
- Improving critical reading, writing and math skills.
- Offering students a unique offsite overnight camp experience.
- Reinforcing the values of selflessness, integrity, discipline and "Nativity Spirit."

This year's program included:

- A one week academic remediation program for any student who did not achieve grade level performance in a core subject
- A two week all day academic and enrichment day camp to focus on core academic needs in the morning followed by enrichment sessions for "experiential learning" in the afternoon
- A one week overnight camp experience at Camp Asbury on Silver Lake, which was clearly the highlight of the year for our students!

Typically the Summer Program is only available to returning students, but this year, we decided to invite all of our incoming students as well. The experience not only offered our new students the many advantages of the program, but also gave them an opportunity to begin their immersion into the Nativity community, and become members of the Nativity family!

Our Summer Program is one of the many unique opportunities at Nativity Prep, and it is clear that the experience set our students on the path to a successful academic year!




