FROM THE PRESIDENT:

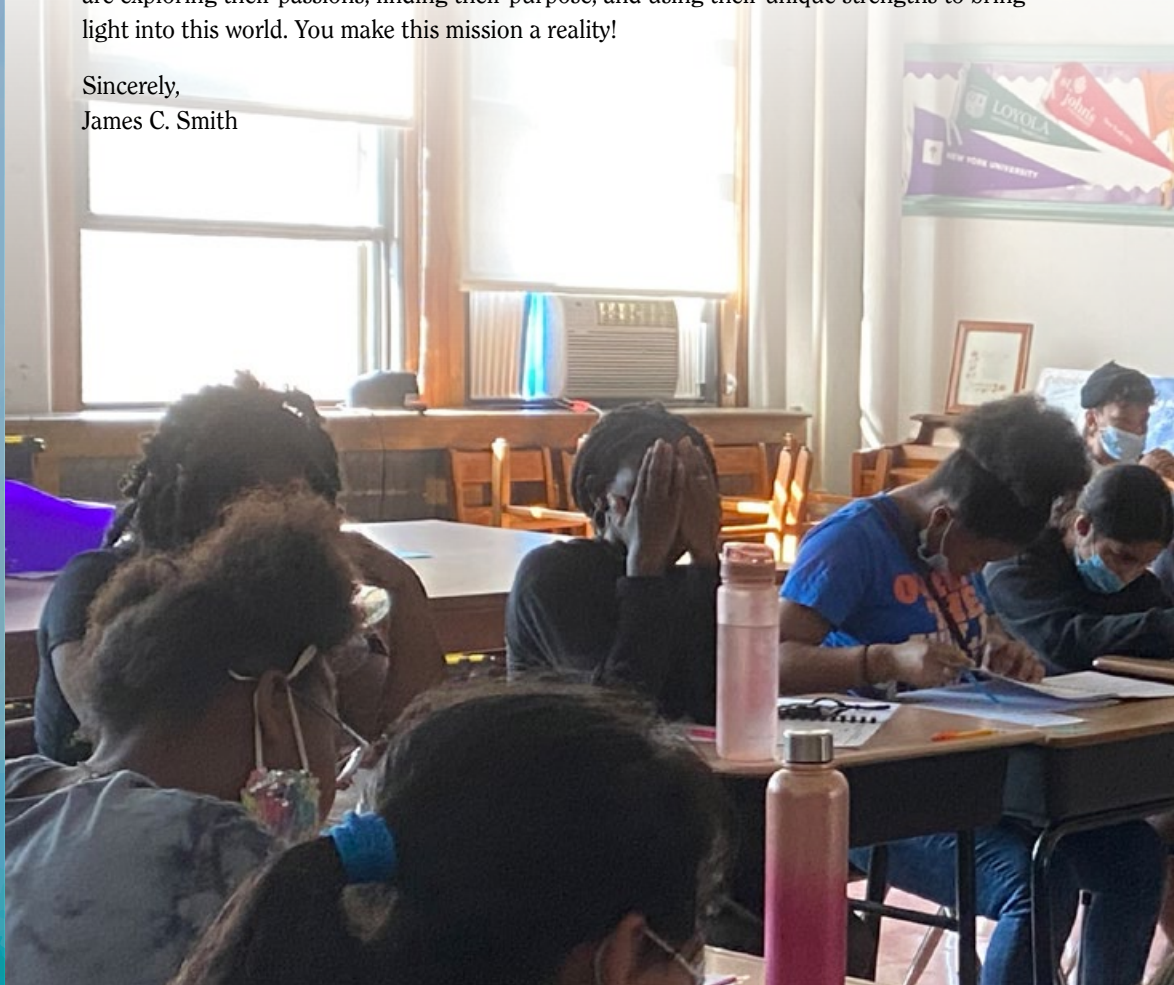

Because of partners like you, our donor-funded and tuition-free model creates a pathway for families in the Rochester region to actualize their full potential. FROM THE PRINCIPAL:

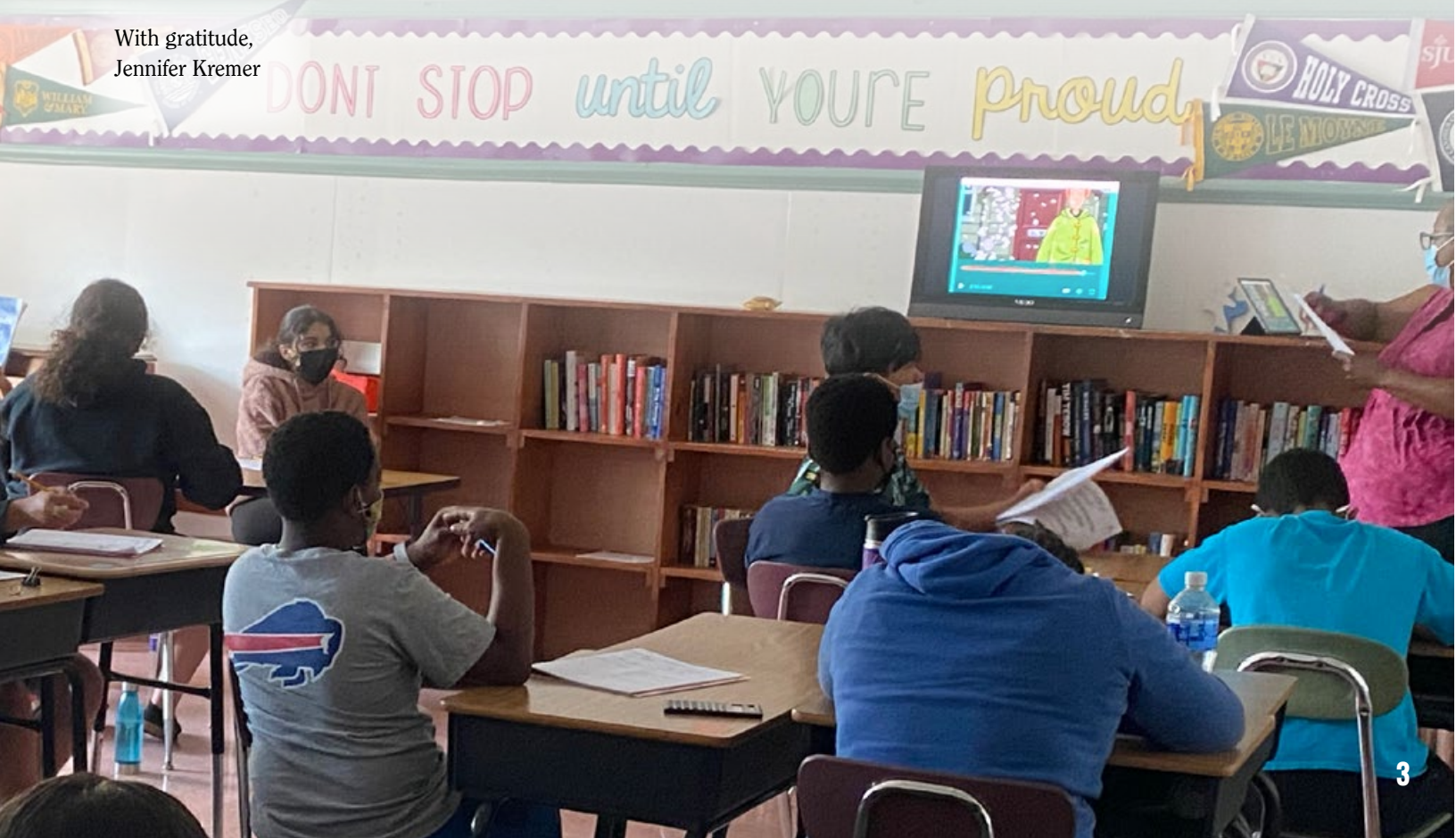

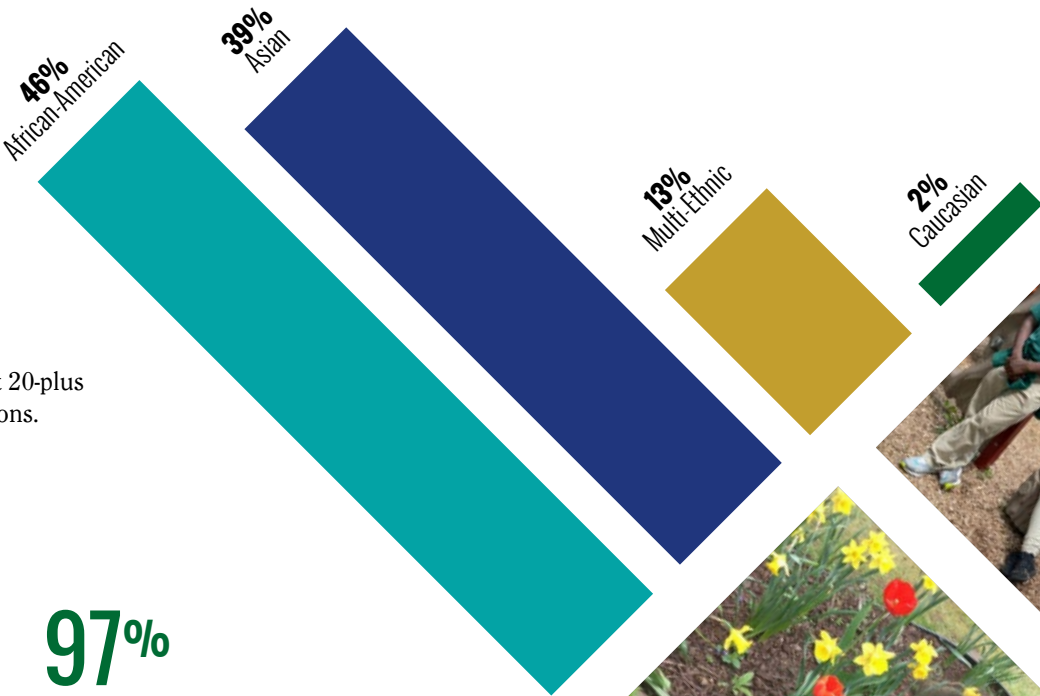

Graduate Support Program Continues the Success

This year was certainly a year for the record books, in more ways than one! This past June we graduated our largest class of graduates in Nativity's history, with 19 young men and women embarking this fall on the next steps of their educational journey in high school. Students will be attending Mercy, McQuaid, Aquinas, Bishop Kearney, Hope Hall, Norman Howard, Vertus, School Without Walls, and Greece Olympia, and all are prepared and capable of succeeding at the highest level in their new environments.

As we celebrate all the accomplishments of our most recent graduates, we also pause to look back over the past decade of Nativity graduations, and the ways in which the Graduate Support Program has grown and taken shape as a holistic network of support for all of Nativity's graduates. Today, Nativity graduates can participate in a variety of activities through our programming, including academic tutoring, social activities, service projects, and mentoring. This past academic year, over half of our high-school-age graduates participated in in-person activities with the Graduate Support Program despite the challenges brought on by the COVID pandemic. We had students in the building for their hybrid learning days, assisting in projects around nativity in support of our middle school program, receiving tutoring and college prep, participating in structured career exploration, and even those who came back to Nativity just to hang out on their days off school!

It has also cemented our understanding that students might want to hang out at their former middle school on the weekend, and that each student is more than capable of sincere and lasting success.

Today, our high school graduation rate is over 97% year after year, and our college persistence rate is more than twice the national average. Each of the 116 graduates who has left our halls have the tools they need for ongoing success in high school and postsecondary education thanks to the Graduate Support Program and all who work to further our mission of educational excellence. We currently have graduates attending public and private four-year colleges, two-year colleges, vocational programs, and those who have joined the military or begun their careers right after high school. As of this year, we even have graduates who have completed four-year degrees and are continuing their education in law school and graduate school. For students from low-income and historically disadvantaged families, our students' success rate is remarkable and we know that with support, consistency, and adults who believe in them, all students, regardless of circumstance, can succeed at the very highest levels. These students will be our community's doctors, lawyers, educators, and leaders, and we could not be more hopeful for the world they will soon help to create.

This program would not be possible without the unwavering support of the Graduate Support Committee, High School Liaisons, community partners, and donors.

And so, we would like to wish a heartfelt thank you to all who have been a part of the Graduate Support Program over the past decade - here's to the next decade of success for Nativity graduates in high school, and beyond!



Building a Graduate Support Program that makes each graduate feel valued, heard, and an important part of the larger Nativity community has been the greatest accomplishment of my tenure over the past three years. We've seen the program grow from a mechanism to ensure high school completion and to monitor academic progress, to a robust web of programs, resources, and opportunities for students.

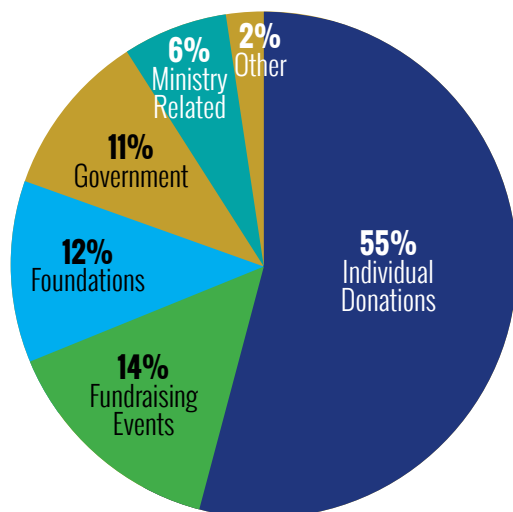

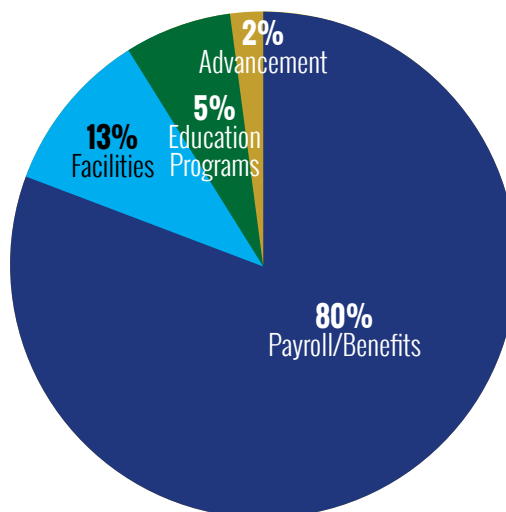
